

The Pilanesberg Game Reserve is one of South Africa's most popular Big 5 game reserves. The geology of the area is fascinating, it has the highest concentration of game and it's rich in history. The reserve is located in a **malaria-free** region in the North West Province.

The game reserve is tucked between the dry, arid Kalahari Desert and the lush, tropical Lowveld region. This makes it an eco-wonderland, where fauna and flora from the different regions blend seamlessly into each other to create a uniquely-balanced ecosystem.

Pilanesberg Game Reserve is small in comparison to the famous Kruger National Park but there are a lot of animals in the reserve. Last count, there were over 7 000 animals in the compact reserve and at least 300 recorded bird species.

It's almost guaranteed you'll have excellent sightings of elephant, rhino, buffalo and lion on a day tour of Pilanesberg as well as other predators, an array of antelope and an abundance of plains game.

# **TOUR ITINERARY**

After collecting you from your hotel or residence in Johannesburg or Pretoria early morning (any time from 05h15 depending on what arrangement has been made), we travel to Pilanesberg Game Reserve.

Please note: The drive time from Johannesburg and Pretoria to Pilanesberg Game Reserve is between 2 to 3-hours long. However, it may take longer depending on where we pick up guests and morning traffic in that area. We also stop off along the route for refreshments and a quick breakfast meal (optional and for your own account).

We plan to arrive at Pilanesberg Game Reserve between 9h00 and 9h15. You meet your safari guide and depart at 9h30 for a morning guided safari tour in an open safari vehicle.

Please note: The morning game drive is between 2½ to 3 hours long. The exact timing depends on what you see and whether you spend a bit longer at an exciting animal sighting.

From 12h00 and 13h00, enjoy a light lunch and cooldrink at Pilanesberg Centre which overlooks a large waterhole. There's a small shop at Pilanesberg Centre where you can buy drinks and snacks for later.

The afternoon game drive is in an **open** safari vehicle and is between 1½ to 2-hours long. Again, the exact timing depends on what you see and how long you spend at an animal sighting.

We depart Pilanesberg Game Reserve at 15h15 for the return journey to Johannesburg or Pretoria.

Expect to arrive in the city between 18h00 and 18h30 (the exact drop-off time depends on where you need to be dropped off and traffic at that time of day).
