ACCOMMODATION

This 5-day budget tour through South Africa's famed Garden Route offers a generous dose of the great outdoors – from wineries to untamed wilderness, Tsitsikamma forest to mountain ranges. Bungy jumping and even waterfall ziplining are available for adrenaline seekers, while canoeing in Wilderness or a brief swim in the warm seas of the Indian Ocean are available for nature enthusiasts. Add hiking in Tsitsikamma National Park, quiet in Congo limestone caverns, and ideal wildlife viewing in Addo Elephant National Park, which has the world's densest population of wild elephants. You'll also get nose-to-beak with the world's largest birds in the feather capital of the world, Oudtshoorn, and walk with the world's largest land mammals in the Klein Karoo. If you're feeling adventurous, you can learn to surf on some of the world's best waves or try your hand at sandboarding in Jeffreys Bay. And no epic road trip is complete without a trip down the wine and kindness of the gorgeous Route 62.

ITINERARY

- 1** Depart Cape region early morning for a scenic and relaxing trip as you make your way to the Wilderness area. Drive along the N2 national road and take in the views of the ocean and the forests. Botlierskop Private Game Reserve is a malaria-free area where you can go on an open-air 4x4 safari where there's a wide variety of animals, including the Big Five, zebras, wildebeests, lions, elephants, kudu, and white rhinos, you are in luck. During the game drive, a seasoned game ranger will share his insights about the local fauna. Overnight in the Wilderness/Knysna area.
- 2** Visit the lookout point at the Knysna Heads, a pair of spectacular sandstone cliffs that guard the entrance to the lagoon. Take in the panoramic views of the lagoon and the forest and snap some photos for your memories. Relax in the tranquil coastal towns of Sedgefield or Wilderness and enjoy the slow pace of life. Stroll along the sandy beaches at sunset and savour the serenity of the sea. Treat yourself to a delicious dinner at a rustic beach restaurant or a cosy town eatery. The adventurous have the options of negotiating the Tsitsikamma Zipline or a Bungy Jump. Zipline over river gorges and waterfalls in the Tsitsikamma forest and feel the rush of adrenaline as you glide through the air. Dare to jump from the Bloukrans Bridge, the highest bungee bridge in the world, and plunge 216 meters into the abyss. Or watch the brave souls from the safety of the bridge and cheer them on. Discover the wonders of the Tsitsikamma National Park, a haven for wildlife and nature lovers. Walk along the suspension bridge and the forest footpaths, and marvel at the views of the ocean, the river, and the waterfall. Spot birds, reptiles, and other animals along the way. This region is a playground for outdoor enthusiasts, and for those who prefer to keep their feet on solid ground, a visit to the lush forests of the Tsitsikamma National Park will undoubtedly satisfy your forest fix – from bird watching to game viewing to waterfall chasing. You will overnight in Jeffreys Bay
- 3** Drive to Jeffreys Bay, South Africa's ultimate 'Surf City'. Enjoy the warm Indian ocean waters, the white sandy beaches and the friendly vibe of this coastal town. You can shop for surf wear, try surfing at the world famous spot, or choose from other optional activities such as Beach Horseback Riding. Drive to the Addo national park where you can enjoy an optional guided game drive. You overnight in Addo
- 4** Today you drive to Oudtshoorn and visit the world-famous Congo Caves. Explore the underground wonders of the Congo Caves, a network of limestone chambers with incredible formations and ancient paintings. Choose between the Heritage Tour, a leisurely walk through the main chambers with great acoustics and insights from your guide, or the Adventure Tour, a more challenging route that involves crawling and squeezing through narrow passages. Today's optional activity is some elephant observation in nature. You overnight in Oudtshoorn
- 5** Visit the Congo Ostrich Show Farm and learn about the farming industry, the history and the features of the world's largest bird. You can even test the strength of the ostrich eggs by standing on them. Start your tour to Cape Town, driving through stunning scenery of mountains, farmlands and vineyards. Experience the famous Route 62, the longest wine route in the world, where you can sample local culture, food and wines. Stop for a Wine Tasting and enjoy the views of the Valley of Wine. Non-alcoholic options available for non-drinkers or under legal drinking age.
