MoAfrika Tours now offers an exciting new 5-day nDzuti Safari Camp in Maseke Game Reserve in the Balule North area of the Greater Kruger Park. nDzuti tented bush camp is located in the The Maseke Game Reserve in the Balule North area of the Greater Kruger Park and is operated by Wildlife Encounters. The reserve is made up of four properties totalling 7500 ha that were given to the Maseke Community of Ba-Phalaborwa in April 2014. A fifth property was added to the reserve later, bringing the total area to about 8000 ha (19 800 acres). As a condition of giving back the land, the farms had to be kept as conservation areas. Today, Maseke is a part of the Greater Kruger Park, which is a huge area of land that spans international borders and has many different types of ecosystems. It is an important part of conservation efforts in Africa. The camp looks out onto a waterhole where animals come to drink day and night.

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ACCOMMODATION

The nDzuti Safari Camp was established on the shady slopes of a koppie, which is the term used for rocky outcrops in Africa. In the native Shangaan language, the word “nDzuti” can mean either “shadow” or “shade.” The garden is not fenced in, but it has a small splash pool, hammocks, and a thatched area where you can sit even when it is very hot. The main attraction of the camp is the sparkling swimming pool. It is situated on the terrace so that guests can watch animals come to the waterhole while lounging around the pool. A dining pavilion, a reed boma and a thatched bar finish off the conversation area. At nDzuti, there are four two-room chalets and luxury tents for people to stay in. In an indigenous garden, the four chalets are evenly spaced from each other. The chalets offer a cool and comfortable place to stay all year long. They are big, and each one can fit four people, which makes them a great choice for families. Each chalet has a living room, a patio, and two bedrooms with bathrooms that have both a shower and a tub. The four luxury tents with views of the waterhole are brand new. They give guests the chance to sleep under canvas, which is an unforgettable experience. Having en suite toilets, doors instead of zippers with flaps, and air conditioning added a touch of luxury. The beds in the tents are comfortable, and the interiors are finished off with bedside tables, luggage racks, and mats. The small patio has a table and two “Morris chairs” that were made locally by hand. The bathroom is outside next to the tent and has a flush toilet, a sink, and a shower. French doors lead to a central lounge with a tea and coffee station, wildlife prints, and doors that lead to the bedrooms on either side. Each cabin has its own path that leads to the main pavilion with the dining area and swimming pool.



ITINERARY

1 Guests can expect collection from OR Tambo Airport Bus Terminal by 07:00 for their transfer by road to Balule and nDzuti Camp. You will arrive at the lodge just in time for a light lunch. After lunch, you can unpack, unwind and relax until it is time for the first afternoon safari adventure in an open vehicle. You will return to the lodge after sunset for dinner under the stars around the fire.

2-4 The same itinerary will be followed on Days 2, 3, and 4. You will have to get up early every morning and will only have time for coffee or tea and rusks before an early morning safari in an open vehicle. This is the best time to see the sun rise over the bushveld and catch predators coming back from their night hunts. Back at the camp, there will be a delicious breakfast waiting for you. After that, you can either sleep or go on a short walking safari. Around noon, you'll have a light lunch. After that, you'll have more time to relax, maybe by the pool, before going on an open-air safari drive at sunset. You might see more interesting things on your afternoon safari before heading back to the camp for a traditional meal under the stars and some time to talk about what you saw and did that day.

5 On your last morning, you'll have to get up early again to leave in the open safari vehicle for the last game drive. You'll have another delicious breakfast, and then you'll only have time to gather your bags before leaving the lodge. Your transport will take you back to Johannesburg, where you will be dropped off between 17:30 and 18:00 at the Johannesburg OR Tambo Airport bus terminal.
